Our February 2009 newsletter published research data regarding the Telstra magnetic "Business Cards". At the time, we hypothesised that one of the missing links may have been more than one block of 1,000 cards printed for the same person. We can now reveal this to be true. Janet C Sayer had an additional 1,000 cards printed as "National General Manager" for batch 1276 with the 1,000 cards being numbered 127601000 to 127601999. MEMERSHIP MATTERS

Member Gordon Shoebridge of Queensland has provided valuable information on the "TAI EPTL" cards featured in last month's newsletter. These cards were printed for intended use in LAOS and were subsequently issued in Cambodia. Gordon has referred to Glenn Bellamy's "Complete Guide Phonecards of Australia" published in 1995. This publication shows a printing of 15,000 for the \$50 card and 10,000 for the \$100 card. Gordon provided photocopies of cards with high numbering which verified the above print numbers.
